Last Tuesday evening, our parish was recognized with the Distinguished Service Award for its support of the Sister Maureen Joyce Center. The soup bowl presented to the Parish in appreciation, and letters of congratulations from Congressman Paul Tonko, State Senator Neil Breslin and State Assemblyman John McDonald are on display on a table near the Baptismal font. I thank and congratulate all of you for your support of the work we do for the Center.

This Sunday at the Cathedral at 2:00 PM, the "Rite of Election" will be celebrated. At this ceremony Bishop Scharfenberger will enroll those to be Baptized at the Eater Vigil as "the Elect." He will also welcome and recognize those previously Baptized and now becoming members of our Catholic Church by a profession of faith at the Easter Vigil. They are from all areas of our Diocese of Albany.

Our candidates for Baptism to be enrolled as "The Elect" are: Mykkel Aragon, Holly Cordi and Quira Walker. Our candidates to be received into full Communion are: Eva Blackman, Tony Borgado, Susan O'Connell and Ray Parker.

At the Noon Mass this Sunday, we will have "The Rite of Sending." It is parish recognition of our sending these Catechumens and Candidates to the Rite of Election at the Cathedral. It is a pledge of our prayers and support as they continue their journey of faith.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) is an important part of our Lenten Observance. It is available every Saturday from 3:00 to 3:30 PM, and we will have a special Service with visiting Priests on Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00 PM. There are purple flyers at all the exits listing the times of Confession and Reconciliation Services in the area. It also contains the steps for going to confession, and an examination of conscience. Please take one in preparation for the Sacrament.

## PLEASE NOTE THE DATES OF UPCOMING EVENTS:

LENT: FAST and ABSTINENCE: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and Abstinence. As a sign of our penance, we preserve for the Diocese of Albany the custom of abstinence from meat on the Fridays of Lent. Abstinence binds all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Fasting binds all Catholics who are 18 years of age, but not yet 59. Fasting refers to the quantity of food eaten. Traditionally, fasting calls for only one full meal per day. By retaining these traditions for our Diocese we do not intend that they be interpreted as laws binding under pain of sin, but as customs from which we will not hold ourselves lightly excused. They are expression of our desire to be converted in our hearts, to be reconciled with each other and to love our neighbor.

LENTEN PRESENTATIONS: Please join us for our special 3 week Lenten Sessions taken from Father Robert Barrens' "Catholicism." All sessions will be at 7:00 PM on Thursday evenings in the Forman Room, front of the Church Hall. The session dates and topics are: March 5th - The Communion of Saints (a Vast Company of Witnesses); March 12th - Saints Peter and Paul (the Indispensable Apostles); March 19th – The Eucharist (The Word Made Flesh). Everyone is invited to be part of any one or all of these as a special Lenten activity.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Conducted on the Fridays of Lent at 12:30 PM, right after the noon Mass. Consider coming to Mass and making this a special Friday Holy Hour.
