LENTEN NEWS & NOTES:

PENANCE SERVICE: Our Lenten Reconciliation Service (Confession) will be Monday April 3rd at 7:00 p.m., visiting priests will join us. We also have confession every Saturday from 3:00 pm. – 3:30 p.m.

<u>LENT: FAST and ABSTINENCE:</u> Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast and Abstinence. As a sign of our penance, we preserve for the Diocese of Albany the custom of abstaining from meat on the Fridays of Lent. Abstinence binds all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Fasting binds all Catholics who are 18 years of age, but not yet 59. Fasting refers to the quantity of food eaten. Traditionally, fasting calls for only one full meal per day. By retaining these traditions for our Diocese we do not intend that they be interpreted as laws binding under pain of sin, but as customs from which we will not hold ourselves lightly excused. They are expressions of our desire to be converted in our hearts, to be reconciled with each other and to love our neighbor.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Conducted on the Fridays of Lent at 12:30 PM, right after the noon Mass. Consider coming to Mass, and the stations, and making this a special Friday Holy Hour.
