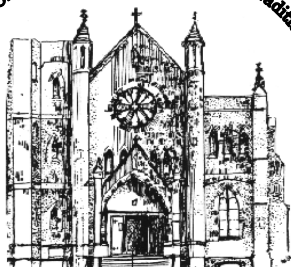

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

Today, with our Fellow Christians around the world, we joyfully celebrate the **Birth of Our Lord, Jesus Christ at Bethlehem**. The world received on that day the **greatest gift** that could be given, the gift of **God Himself**, come to live among us here on earth. **God the Father** sent **Jesus His Son** so that we could know God, know God's love for us and to love and care for each other now empowered and filled by the presence and Spirit of God Himself!

Our presents, our tree, the decorations, our dinners, etc, should all remind us of the great gift of Christmas. God in Jesus has come to us, to be our joy, our peace, our hope.

The Christmas Season now continues until **January 7th**. Next Sunday we celebrate the **Feast of the Holy Family** and on Monday New Year's Day, and the **Solemnity of Mary the Holy Mother of God**. On Sunday, January 7th, we **Celebrate the Epiphany Of the Lord**, the revelation of Christ to ALL the nations of the world symbolized by the coming of the Kings to Bethlehem, a very special Feast for Hispanic families here, and our Shrine Church of the Lady of the Americas. Please keep your Christmas Crib and decorations up until this Feast to celebrate this Holy Season.

In preparation for Christmas the entire Parish Family and other groups and parishes have reached out to the poor, the infirmed, the shut ins, and nursing home residents as a sign of the love and care of Jesus present within us and among us. While those words are more evident at this Christmas time, they go on in our parish family throughout the year.

Through the Christmas Giving Tree we were able to help 135 families with 291 children. Over 900 gifts were given by you, and parishioners of All Saints Parish. In addition, various organizations, offices, schools, businesses, and others provided for the needs of 52 of our own school families providing over 600 gifts for the children and food vouchers for all of the above families.

Our school children collected hats and gloves for our soup kitchen, went caroling for our soup kitchen guests, and at Colonie Center. They also sent cards to all our shut-ins. Our youth group did caroling for the residents of the Atria in Delmar and collected items for our food pantry.

The Parish Thrift Shop made extra efforts to have Christmas items displayed and available as well as a host other items for Christmas and winter use. The Rosary Guild also sent Christmas cards and notes to our shut-ins and nursing home parishioners.

These and many other events and service projects show the results of Christ coming, and forming us into a community of faith, caring for others as members of Gods own family.

I want to thank personally and on behalf of the Parish Family, all who help make Christmas so special. They include Ed Savoy and our choir, those who decorated the Church, Pete Krasher and helpers, those who helped with everything inside and outside the Church, our Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, servers and greeters. Thank you to these and all of you who make everything possible.

Sr. Jude, Fr. Juanito and I extend to you our prayerful best wishes for a Blessed Christmas and a peace-filled, healthy New Year. Please accept our sincere thanks for all that you do for our Parish Family and for the many cards, notes and remembrances you shared with us at this season. Be assured of remembrance in our prayers.

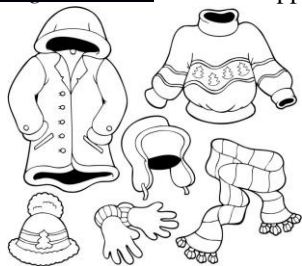
LEGION OF MARY: Meets every Tuesday at 6:00 PM in the Forman Room.
