FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

This **Wednesday is Ash Wednesday**, the beginning of our Lenten Observance. The <u>Masses</u> on that day are 7:00AM, 10:00AM, 12:00 NOON, and 5:00PM. The ashes placed on our forehead are a sign of our willingness to enter into the retreat days of Lent in preparation for the Easter Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil) and the renewal of our Baptismal promises on Easter Sunday. Our Lenten works of fasting, prayer, a growing awareness of others and their needs, all help us become more aware of the presence of Christ in our lives. Please enter into this Season of Spiritual Renewal and pray for the openness to grow spiritually, individually, and as a Parish Family. Please look over the bulletin of Lenten devotions and activities. I would ask you to consider the daily masses at 7:00AM and 12:00 NOON, as part of your Lenten observance- possibly coming once or daily; also gifts to the poor though our poor boxes, scripture reading, Stations of the Cross, and increase in good works, such as visiting older folks at home or in a nursing home, helping with Parish programs or family member's needs.

COLLECTION NEWS: Regular: \$10,630.00. When away, please remember your parish envelope gift upon your return. We appreciate your ongoing support. LENTEN NEWS & NOTES

ASH WEDNESDAY: Ash Wednesday masses and distribution of ashes will be at 7:00am, 10:00am, 12:00pm, and 5:00pm. In a Lenten Spirit of concern for the poor, the collection that day will be for our food pantry here at Blessed Sacrament

LENT: FAST and ABSTINENCE: Ash Wednesday *and* **Good Friday** are days of fast and Abstinence. As a sign of our penance, we preserve for the Diocese of Albany the custom of abstinence from meat on the Fridays of Lent. Abstinence binds all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Fasting binds all Catholics who are 18 years of age, but not yet 59. Fasting refers to the quantity of food eaten. Traditionally, fasting calls for only one full meal per day. By retaining these traditions for our Diocese we do not intend that they be interpreted as laws binding under pain of sin, but as customs from which we will not hold ourselves lightly excused. They are expression of our desire to be converted in our hearts, to be reconciled with each other and to love our neighbor.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Conducted on the Friday's of Lent at 12:30 PM, right after the noon Mass. Consider coming to Mass, and the stations, and making this a special Friday Holy Hour.

<u>OPERATION RICE BOWL</u>: As we begin our Lenten Journey, you are invited to participate in Catholic Relief Services, Operation Rice Bowl. Throughout Lent we will pray, fast, learn, and give as a way to reach our in solidarity with our brothers/sisters around the world. They can be returned to us on Palm Sunday.
