FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

Personally, and on behalf of the Parish Family, I am happy to welcome one of our Seminarians, Kyle Eavs to our Parish for a 10 week summer learning program. Kyle has completed his college program and in September will begin Theology studies at St. Joseph Seminary in Dunwoodie, NY. Please keep him and all of our seminarians and discerners in your prayers.

Last Sunday we asked you to consider the Governor's plan called, "The Parental Choice in Education Act." It will provide tax credits to low-income families who send their children to Catholic Schools and other schools; also, scholarships to students from lowmiddle income families to attend a school of their choice; donations to public schools for enhanced educational programming and tax credits to teachers for their out of pocket classroom expenses.

This would definitely help parents of our Parish School, and so I ask you to support the plan. You can do this by calling your assembly person to register your support. The bill is now stalled in the Assembly. There are flyers at all exits explaining the plan, and the phone numbers for John McDonald and Patricia Fahey, if your representative is different, please call them. This will be decided in the next week, maybe by the time you read these notes. Thank you for your consideration, please give flyers to others who may offer support.

Today we celebrate the Patronal Feast of our Parish. The gift of the Blessed Sacrament, The Holy Eucharist, is a sign of and a source of our unity as the Body of Christ. It is also food for our spiritual journey of life, and a pledge and promise of our future glory when the journey of life here is completed. On this Feast we give thanks for all the blessings God has given us and we ask God's continued blessings as we continue the work of Jesus here in our Parish. At all of our Masses today, we are commissioning our extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion for a period of one year. The Commission is to be exercised at our Masses here, and for our parishioners homebound or living in nursing homes, etc. The Commission does not apply beyond our parish and for our parishioners. You can help elsewhere with the approval and request of the Pastor or Chaplain of that place. Your ministry serves our Parish Community and, in a special way, our homebound. Thank you to all who serve in this ministry.

SCHOOL NEWS: We are accepting registrations for next year. Please call the school for more information or to set up an appointment. We offer quality Catholic education from 3-year old nursery to 8th grade. The 3 and 4 year old programs are offered for full or half day. FAMILY FESTIVAL: We are always looking ahead, and planning for our many Parish events and activities. Our *Annual Family* Festival will be held on Saturday, October 17th. We are currently looking for people who can help prepare and cook for the food served in the Church Hall on that day. We have people who do the acquisition and purchasing of the food, but we are in need of cooks.
