You can reach out to family and neighbors (call folks on the phone, use your social media, talk with each other, pray together). Listen. Help one another. Above all, keep in touch!

BLESSED SACRAMENT SCHOOL NEWS: The faculty, staff and students of Blessed Sacrament School are keeping all members of Blessed Sacrament Parish close in prayer for their safety and health during this challenging time.
