FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK: It's been almost three months since last gathered together to share Word and Sacrament here at Blessed Sacrament! I hope you and your family are safe.

JUNE 7. 2020

Bishop Scharfenberger sent all the pastors and parish life directors an email shortly after Memorial Day requesting that every parish prepare a plan for re-opening their parish to celebrate Eucharist and the sacraments. We have formed our Re-Opening Coordinating Committee; our members are Julie Hasselbarth, Peter Krasher, Ed Savoy and David Strazzeri. We have completed our plan and submitted it

to the Diocese. We believe we've addressed their concerns.

The Bishop does not have a date to re-open our parishes for public liturgy but he does want us to be ready when that time comes.

When we do return for Mass, some things will be different. The corona virus has driven some changes. There will be social distancing. People will use masks and hand sanitizers. We will need more ushers to help with seating people at Mass to ensure distancing. We will have Eucharist only in the form of the Body of Christ; that means on Saturdays that Deacon Gerry Ladoceur and I will be ministers of the Eucharist at the Vigil and on Sundays there will be one Eucharistic Minister distributing the Body of Christ with me at our three Masses. This is being done to minimize the potential for transmitting the corona virus

We will continue to schedule two lectors for our weekend Masses. Temporarily we will not have altar servers at Mass. Temporarily, the choir will not be leading us in song on Sunday. Temporarily, I will need six to eight ushers at every weekend Mass. Let me ask: would you serve us in this special need in a special time? I really need your help. I will have training sessions for all Ushers (current and new) in the church on Tuesday, June 9 and Wednesday, June 10 at 12:30 pm and 6:30 pm. I will also have some more training sessions on Monday, June 15 and Tuesday, June 16 at 12:30 pm and 6:30 pm.

Thank you for helping during this transition time as we minister to our families, neighbors and friends.
