FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK: September is just around the corner and people are wondering what the Fall will bring with COVID-19. We want to be completely ready for the future because your safety and the safety of your family matters to us.

At Blessed Sacrament, we are voluntarily taking some time to evaluate our parish's compliance with state and Department of Health guidelines and mandates to ensure your safety. We did not celebrate Mass on Friday, July 24th and we will not be open for worship this weekend or for the next several days. We will notify you when our evaluation is done and when will be reopening.

We were among the first churches to reopen to serve you and your families largely because of the good work of our Reopening Coordinating Committee. We want to ensure that Blessed Sacrament continues to be a safe place to gather and give thanks and praise to God. So we will take a pause and look forward to being back soon.

We've been open for six weekends. No positive tests. No quarantines. We've collected contact tracing forms at all of those Masses and we haven't had to make any calls to anyone about positive tests for the corona virus. Our closure is about time to evaluate our compliance. It is not driven by test results. There is no need for treatment or quarantine. Thank you for all the steps you've taken here and at home using masks, social distancing, using hand sanitizer and exercising care. All of this, done together, pays off for everyone.
