DIOESEAN APPEAL: Hopefully by now most parishioners have received information through the mail about this year's Diocesan Appeal (Bishop's Appeal). Despite this year's difficulties, I'd still ask that we all be as generous as possible, if possible equaling last year's gift, as I plan to do. Our goal this year for Blessed Sacrament and the Shrine is about \$98,000 (\$23,000 less than last year's goal).
