From the Deacon's Bench

All four Gospels tell the story of Jesus entering Jerusalem. Jesus's entry into Jerusalem was prophesied by Zechariah who wrote, "Behold, your king is coming to you, a savior is he, humble and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey." The fact that Jesus enters the city humbly and not as a conquering ruler reveals the identity and purpose of Jesus: the Kingdom he will bring can be established only through his suffering a death.

This Friday is Good Friday, and it's our last communal day of fasting for a while. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, everyone 14 years or older abstains from meat, and those 18 and older but younger than 60 fast. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The seriously ill and pregnant and nursing mothers are exempt from fasting.

Fasting and abstinence are meant to bring our hearts and minds closer to God. The emptiness in our stomach reminds us of the true needs in our hearts which can only be filled by Christ. Fasting and abstaining helps us train ourselves to seek what is above, and not to gorge ourselves on the things of earth, which can only satisfy partially.

Reaching Out To Our Neighbors - We have reached out to our neighbors with a bulletin mailing to the entire 12206 zip code. I would like to thank Mandy Kennedy and Lisa Diffenback for their contributions to this effort. This is hopefully an ice-breaker for us all. People have seen, through this, a little of who we are, and all of us, in our conversations with our neighbors and at local institutions and businesses, may be able to flesh out it out by sharing our own personal dedication to our parish and our Lord. Share the good news we have received, and encourage others to believe with us, pray with us, work with us, and live with us, especially those who may be low on hope or be weak in their relationship with Jesus.

Faith Formation As we prepare for Holy Week, we're encouraging parishioners to make art work based on the readings and holy days. The art work will be displayed in the church vestibule and one piece will be chosen and displayed in our parish bulletin. Everyone is encouraged to participate.
