From the Pastor: Olympic athletes don't exist by accident; it takes a lot of work. Gold doesn't exist in brick form in nature; it must be mined and purified. Racehorses don't win their first time out; they require a lot of patient training. Neither are ordained or consecrated people hatched. They must engage in years of training, purifying, exercising. When our Fr. Charles was ordained last fall, it was the at the end of training for him that started when he was 12 years old. Similarly, our seminarian Louis Namugera begins the next phase of his seminary formation when he begins Theology at St. Mary Major Seminary in Baltimore this fall. Blessed Sacrament has been a home and a support to Louis since he came to Albany, and we want to continue to support him in his formation.

Priestly formation costs about \$50,000 per year, all of which is paid by the diocese through gifts to the Diocesan Appeal. If you haven't made a gift the annual appeal yet, please do so, even if it's just a few dollars, so that we can all say that we've helped in Louis' formation for priesthood.

Meanwhile, we are all always in formation. We all ought to strive to continue to grow in faith and virtue and strength and holiness. We are all saints-in-themaking, and we must make intentional, principled, deliberate, sacrificial actions, (oftentimes that go against the current of the culture, which usually prefers to settle into easy, comfortable, routines). Let us strenuously do our best to pray and act, and allow ourselves to be made into saints by our God.
