FROM THE DEACON'S BENCH

Last month, the diocese participated in the "Called by Name" program, which is always ongoing — and if you think you might know someone who would make a good priest, please tell us. I am also adding an additional challenge: Do you recall how full the church was just five years ago before covid? Blessed Sacrament and All Saints had three well-attended Masses each, and Mater Christi had four! Each parish now only has two Sunday Masses. We have gone from 10 Masses to six, and none of the Masses are as well attended as before. Where did everyone go? Many just stopped coming, and it is indicative of what we see in the Church in general. People have stopped coming to church, especially after covid. These are people who attended church regularly and may be inclined to return — if someone asks them. I am asking if each of you can invite just two people to come to church with you. If just one starts coming regularly, we will double our congregation. If we can rejuvenate our church, we will rejuvenate the calling to ordained and religious life. This is the perfect time to ask people to come to church as we approach the Advent and Christmas seasons with all their beautiful music and imagery. On Blessed Sacrament's part, we need to make sure that our liturgies are meaningful where people can experience the presence of God in word, music, preaching, and liturgy. Together, I think we can do this and revive our parish, and in doing so an increase in vocations will follow. Remember to pray not only for vocations but also that the spiritually hungry can satisfy that hunger by returning to Mass. ~Deacon Gerry
