FROM THE PASTOR

The temple at the time Jesus was born is Jerusalem's "Second Temple". The first one had been ransacked and ultimately destroyed when Israel was conquered by the Babylonians. When it had been rebuilt, it wasn't quite the same as it used to be. It wasn't as splendid; some corners were cut. The most significant loss was the reason the temple was built in the first place: the Ark of the Covenant, which is generally believed to be lost ever since.

The Ark was God's presence; his physical presence. In the Ark was a jar of manna, and Aaron's staff, but most importantly it held the tablets with the 10 commandments. God wrote them. They were his words, and the evidence of their covenant with him.

So though the priests and the people had gotten back to all the activities of the temple, the prayers and sacrifices and presentations of babies, there had always been a sense of something being missing. People were still waiting hopefully for the Lord to enter his temple once again!

With Mary & Joseph carrying baby Jesus into the temple, the Lord has once again taken his place in his temple; the Light of the World has taken its place in its lampstand! But the Lord has also taken his place in his throne in each of his people. This is why we don't take Baptism, or Confirmation, or the Eucharist lightly, because God is powerfully present in those sacraments, and when he enters into each of us, we also become temples of the Holy Spirit where God is enthroned.


