## FROM THE DEACON'S BENCH

On the second Sunday of Lent, we move from Jesus's retreat to the desert and temptation by the devil to the glory shown in Jesus's Transfiguration. The report of Jesus's Transfiguration is found in each of the synoptic Gospels — Matthew, Mark, and Luke. The context for Luke's account of the Transfiguration occurs after Peter's confession that Jesus is the Messiah and Jesus's prediction of his Passion. This encourages us to examine the Transfiguration in the larger context of the Paschal Mystery.

The three disciples see Jesus transfigured and Elijah and Moses present with Jesus. Elijah and Moses, both significant figures in the history of Israel, represent Jesus's continuity with the law and the prophets. On witnessing Jesus's Transfiguration, his disciples are stricken in awe. Then, having awoken, they hear a voice from heaven — the same voice that was heard at Jesus's baptism which, in Luke's Gospel, spoke directly to Jesus as God's Son.

In Jesus's Transfiguration, we see an anticipation of the glory of his Resurrection. In each of the reports of the Transfiguration, the disciples keep secret what they have seen. Not until they also witness his Passion and death will the disciples understand Jesus's Transfiguration. We hear this story of Jesus's Transfiguration early in Lent, but we have the benefit of hindsight. In our hearing of it, we anticipate Jesus's Resurrection even as we prepare to remember Jesus's Passion and death. *~Deacon Gerry*


