

## WHAT IS DIVINE MERCY?

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us – all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

From 1931-1938 Jesus appeared to then Sr. Faustina Kowalska (now St. Faustina), a young Polish nun, and gave her messages that were not only for her own spiritual growth but that of the world. While the revelation to St. Faustina is recent, the message of Divine Mercy is woven deep within our Church teachings and Sacred Scripture. The message of Divine Mercy is this:

• Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.

• Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us. Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

Please join us on Sunday at 3:00 for the final day of the Divine Mercy Novena, started on Good Friday. From 1:30 to 3:00, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, during which we will pray the Novena with Mass following at 3:30 pm
