Each year at the Chrism Mass the Bishop blesses the Oil of the Sick, the Oil of Catechumens, and the holy Chrism. These oils are presented to each parish for use during the year.

The oils will be brought up as part of the entrance procession.

Oil of the Sick

This Oil of the Sick has been blessed by our Bishop for the healing of body, mind, and soul.

May the sick, who are anointed with it, experience the compassion of Christ and his saving love.

Oil of Catechumens

This Oil of Catechumens has been blessed by our Bishop for the anointing of those preparing for Baptism.

Through this anointing they are strengthened by Christ to resist the power of Satan and reject evil in all its forms, as they prepare for the saving waters of Baptism.

Holy Chrism

This holy Chrism, a mixture of olive oil and perfume, has been consecrated by our Bishop and the Priests of our Diocese. It will be used to anoint infants after Baptism, those who are to be confirmed, Bishops and Priests at their Ordination, and altars and churches at the time of their dedication.

Processional: Lift High The Cross - Sydney H. Nicholson/George W. Kitchin


Refrain: Lift high the cross, the love of Christ proclaim, till all the world adore his sacred name.

- 5) So shall our song of triumph ever be; praise to the Crucified for victory. (*Refrain*)




Penitential Act







Save us, Sav-ior of the world, for by your Cross and Re-sur-rec-tion you have set us free.





11:00 AM - Blessing of food


