That the World Might Grow in Compassion

Each year, the Pope asks for our prayers for a specific intention each month. For June 2025 (which is also dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus), he would like for us to pray that "each one of us might find consolation in a personal relationship with Jesus, and from his heart, learn to have compassion on the world." Along these lines, this past Tuesday, May 27th, was "K" for "Kindness Day" at Blessed Sacrament School as part of the ABC Countdown to the end of the school year. For my students in Grade 3 religion class, I shared a lesson on St. Veronica, the patron saint of kindness. She earned this title for bravely stepping out from the crowd and offering Jesus a cloth to wipe his face as he journeyed toward the cross to be crucified. She risked so much — her own life, really — to perform this simple act of human dignity, as many people in the crowd were extremely angry and violent and there were Roman soldiers everywhere.

Sometimes, we might feel that our simple acts don't really matter or won't make a difference in the world ... but that thought couldn't be farther from the truth! Matthew 25:40 tells us, "... whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me." God gifted St. Veronica with a spirit of empathy, compassion, and kindness. May we also call upon the Holy Spirit to guide us and give us the strength and courage to reach out to others in this way, even when the situation might be difficult! Lord Jesus, help make our hearts like yours!



A Note from Ms. Jensen

I cannot believe that May is ending and **June** is upon us! We've had a terrific year of Faith Formation, and I want to thank everyone who made it possible: our beloved families, our outstanding catechists, our amazing Faith Formation coordinator Shannon Crisafulli, our dedicated clergy and staff members at Blessed Sacrament Church and Blessed Sacrament School, and our entire Blessed Sacrament community for their constant prayers and support!

Our first Faith Formation gathering took place on Catechetical Sunday (September 15, 2024), and we tried something new: inviting **entire families** to participate! Instead of dropping off their children and coming back at dismissal time, parents stayed for their own faith-sharing group — and it blossomed beyond anything I could have possibly envisioned! Many adults in the group even said that they want to continue meeting even though Faith Formation sessions have ended for the year! One adult told me that she has never before had a place where she could share about her faith and is extremely grateful to be part of this group. We've really created a "support system" in many ways — for exploring our faith, discussing parenting-related topics and challenges, hearing other parents' experiences and insights, brainstorming ways to develop and encourage our children's faith, and overall just growing in faith together.

The overarching theme for this Faith Formation year was "The Beatitudes" (found in Matthew and Luke's Gospels). Each month, we explored one Beatitude with questions such as, "What does this mean in our own lives?" and "How can we live out Jesus's teachings daily?". The etymology of the word "Beatitudes" comes from the Latin beatus, or "blessed," which is also part of the name of our church and school and we are truly blessed indeed! (By the way, if anyone has an idea for next year's Faith Formation theme, please let me know! I'm always open to suggestions!)

On a personal note, I'm quickly approaching my one-year anniversary of working here at Blessed Sacrament. In addition to Faith Formation, I teach the Catholic faith to Grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 at Blessed Sacrament School, I feel absolutely honored to serve at Blessed Sacrament and know firsthand how special our community is. With one year almost under my belt, I feel super excited about making plans for this next year of faith enrichment! Thank you so much to everyone who has been incredibly welcoming and has helped me so much along the way!

Plans are underway for a Vacation Bible School here at Blessed Sacrament during the week of July 7th through 11th. Children entering kindergarten through Grade 5 this fall will be eligible to participate, and children in Grades 6 and older may serve as our VBS leaders! Watch for more information! Make sure to "like" us on Facebook and visit our website from time to time. Also remember that Faith Formation doesn't end just because school is out or Faith Formation sessions have concluded. Faith is a *lifelong* journey!
