#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Paul and Barnabas, Barsabbas and Silas, set out to change the world! Sure, they were sent by the apostles, the Church. But they were sent by God! They were sent by God to change the world.

For them or for us, going out on this mission is not without its difficulties, including internally, as we hear in today's first reading. These conflicts mostly boil down to a need for clarification. Certainly, this is a need regularly throughout the history of the Church. This past Tuesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, we celebrated the 1,700<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Council of Nicæa and the composition of the Nicene Creed, which clarified the basics, the core, of what we believe as Christians.

But long before 325, one of the first conflicts that arose is what we hear about in today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles: Do people need to be Jewish in order to be Christian? Ultimately, it was determined that yes, anyone could be Christian, and no, they did not need to become Jewish or follow all the practices of the Jewish people to become a Christian. Consequently, there is no Catholic or Christian religious reason for circumcision. Baby boys do not need to be circumcised. Rather, the command is to "circumcise your hearts," a biblical phrase from both Old and New Testaments — a metaphorical phrase used to encourage us to cut away everything that keeps us from loving God and others properly. ~Fr.
