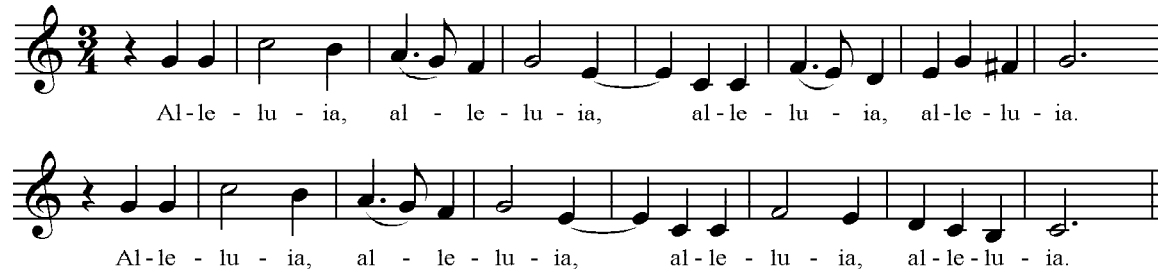
Glo-ry to God in the high-est, and on earth peace, peace to peo-ple of good will. We
