

From Lisanne Jensen, Faith formation Teacher: How much time do you spend each day waiting on something? If you're a student, perhaps you wait for the school bus to arrive in the morning. Then, in class you raise your hand and wait for your teacher to respond. You might wait in line for your lunch in the cafeteria. When you're at home, relaxing by playing on your phone or tablet, you might feel impatient waiting for your favorite video game to load (or for spotty wi-fi to work again!). You might even find it difficult to wait for your birthday to finally arrive or for a beloved family member to come visit. Grownups usually spend a lot of time waiting in traffic, waiting in line at the grocery store, waiting on the phone to talk with customer service, waiting at the dentist's office, waiting on the results of a medical test... and as an expectant parent, eagerly waiting for your child to enter the world. In other words, this world requires much waiting (and patience). Is it possible, however, to find any joy in waiting? This weekend, we mark the First Sunday of Advent. We're waiting for Christmas to arrive, when we celebrate Jesus's birth. Waiting might sometimes seem like a burden instead of a blessing, but waiting is often part of our spiritual journey. During these times of anticipation, we can deepen our faith and experience personal growth. Psalm 27:14 encourages us to "Wait for the Lord; take courage; be stouthearted, wait for the Lord!". James 1:2-4 advises, "Consider it all joy, my brothers, when you encounter various trials, for you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance." Waiting definitely isn't easy, but God's wisdom can help us through it. Also, take advantage of everything offered at church during this Advent season: Mass, prayer services, Reconciliation, Faith Formation, opportunities to serve others, and much more! Maybe we can try to embrace the peace that comes from knowing that God is at work, even if we can't see or sense it immediately. Never ceasing to pray and worship God can renew your spirit and fill you with much joy, even while waiting!
