#### MASS WITH BISHOP MARK O'CONNELL

Bishop Mark O'Connell will be saying Mass here on Sunday, December 21st at the 9am.

Advent is a season of waiting. We wait with eager longing for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Yet, in an age of same-day delivery, streaming services, and smartphones I know of few words in common usage that are as despised as the verb "wait." In our age of convenience waiting is a frustrating reality. Yet, on this third Sunday of Advent, also called Gaudete Sunday, the Church not only bids us to wait for the Lord, but to wait with joy; to rejoice and take joy in our waiting. As our entrance antiphon states: "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near." How can one possibly rejoice when what – or better, who – is desired is not yet present? How can one possibly rejoice when one is waiting? To help answer this difficult question, I would like you to imagine a child on Christmas Eve. Is that child angry or joyful? Bored or excited? In my experience, that child will likely be joyful and excited. In fact, any child will ordinarily be overcome with giddiness for the coming day. Why? Because children believe – they have faith (albeit natural faith and hope) – that Santa is going to bring them what they desire, which is nothing other than the gifts that they already love. That faith, hope, and love for the gifts transforms the entire experience of waiting. It ceases to be tedious and frustrating, and becomes pleasant and joyful. This third Sunday of Advent, then, let's learn from our children. When we are waiting, whether we be waiting in line at the store, at a restaurant, or in traffic, stop dwelling on the fact that you do not yet have what you want, but rather remember that you are soon to receive the gift that you desire. In other words, stop lamenting what you do not yet have and begin anticipating what you will soon receive. Life is ultimately filled with waiting: waiting in sickness, waiting in poverty, waiting in loneliness. In the midst of it all we Christians are called to wait with joyful anticipation, something that is only possible if we cease dwelling on what we do not have, and begin remembering Him in whom we have all and from whom we receive all: Jesus Christ. As our joy in the midst of waiting will be commensurate with our faith, hope, and love in and for Jesus, this Sunday ask Him to increase these theological virtues. For in believing, hoping, and loving Him all the more, you will more readily wait for His coming with joy.
