FROM FATHER DAN

There comes a time in each parish priest's life when he no longer looks around a congregation and thinks "I'm going to offer all your funerals; I'm going to bury you all" and instead thinks "you all are going to bury me". Now, I haven't arrived at that point yet, but recently, this November, the month of prayer for All Souls, we have had a number of funerals of people in their 50s (one of them my cousin), and one 10-year-old. My perception as to who I'm going to bury and not going to bury has been challenged. I've been reminded that tomorrow is not assured for me, or anyone, on this Earth. This is not to say that I am particularly unhealthy in any way, but one can never know for sure what a day brings. It's important for me to be aware of my mortality, otherwise, I end up like the character in Jesus' "Parable of the Rich Fool": after saving up so

Jesus' "Parable of the Rich Fool": after saving up so many good things, the rich man is told, "tonight, your life is expected of you". The plans he made, the priorities he had, all must be abandoned; God's timing takes precedence. Let's be sure to live our lives as if each day was precious, and indeed could be our last here, and take care to treasure the things that God prioritizes for us each day, knowing that as a loving father, he does act in our best interest.
