REMADE FOR MISSION UPDATE

On Wednesday, November 17th about 80 parishioners from our parish network (St. Vincent's, Blessed Sacrament, All Saints, Mater Christi, the Shrine Church) met at the Hibernian Hall for a Synodal gathering.

The two prompts that would be discussed in small table groups had been posted in the parishes in the weeks prior:

- (1) "I would invite someone to my parish because...",
and (2) "To grow as a disciple, a follower of Christ, I need...".

Now that the Working Group who designed that gathering has met and reflected on the responses and conversations, we are ready to share what we noted:

Prompt #1: "Yes, I would invite someone to my parish because..."

(Below is a sampling of responses synthesized from the table reports)

- We are a welcoming parish
- I feel safe and welcomed
- We have a vibrant, growing community
- Great music
- Good homilies that make you think
- Outreach and service opportunities
- Lots of ways to be involved in the parish • Welcoming to families
- Disability accessible
- Sense of care and community
- Check in on and visit homebound
- Feel better, more at peace after Mass

Prompt #2: "To grow as a disciple, a follower of Christ, I need..."

(Below is a sampling of responses synthesized from the table reports)

- Someone to talk with, and ongoing encouragement and support
- Be engaged with the outside world
- Music, readings, ritual, quiet
- Good programming for adults
- Outreach and service opportunities
- A strong faith community
- Encouragement, friends and fun
- A community who responds to the call to serve

Next Steps- and Save the Dates: As a result of a deeper look at your responses, and given that Bishop Mark has asked us to "pause" the Remade for Mission pastoral planning process, we felt that we could use this time to create network and city wide opportunities that focus on providing new opportunities that are designed to enrich our lives and the lives of our parish communities. We will focus on designing programs that are spiritually enriching, and outreach opportunities that seek to identify and meet the needs of our surrounding communities. One such opportunity will be coming up on March 23-26th. Our network will be having a four day/Lenten Mission and Retreat in which each parish will a host session on at least one of the days. This subcommittee met January 8th, and we hope the Holy Spirit will help surface our theme and general outline/flow for the retreat. Be on the lookout for more details.
