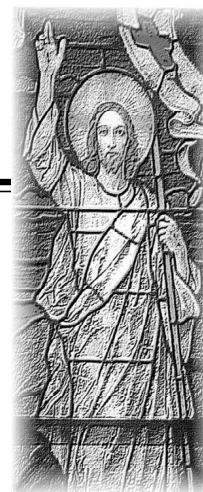


The 2nd Sunday of Easter at Blessed Sacrament Church

Processional: **Alleluia! Let The Holy Anthem Rise**

- 1) Alleluia! Alleluia! Let the holy anthem rise, And the choirs of heaven chant it in the temple of the skies; Let the mountains skip with gladness and the joyful valleys ring with hosannas in the highest to our Savior and our King!
- 2) Alleluia! Alleluia! Like the sun from out the wave, He has risen up in triumph from the darkness of the grave. He's the splendor of the nations; He's the lamp of endless day; He's the very Lord of glory who is risen up today!
- 3) Alleluia! Alleluia! Blessed Jesus, make us rise, From the life of this corruption, To the life that never dies. May we share with you your glory, When the days of time are past, And the dead shall be awakened, By the trumpet's mighty blast!

*On Sundays, especially in Easter Time, the blessing
and sprinkling of water as a memorial of Baptism may take place.
This rite takes the place of the usual Penitential Act at the beginning of mass.*
