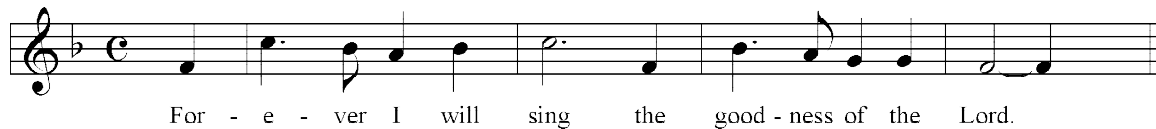

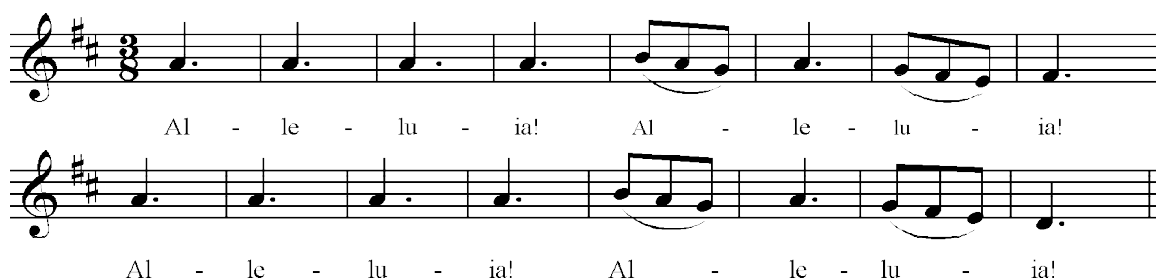

Offertory: **Baptized In Water**

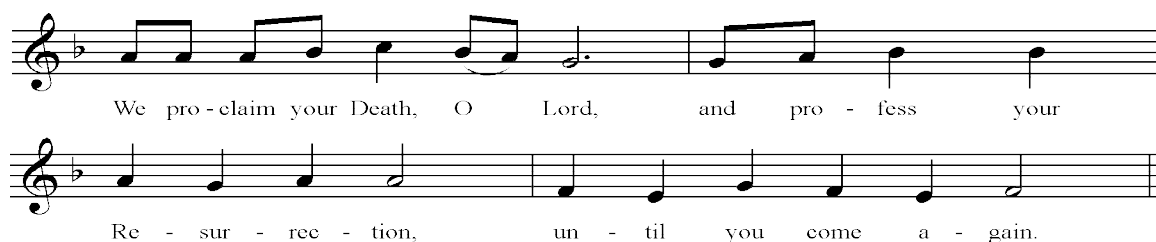
1) Baptized in water, Sealed by the Spirit,
